# WRE and Danish Championships Long Distance 2023

**Sunday, September 10, 2023 in Rosenvoldskovene**

**Classification** World Ranking Event.

**Venue** Marking from Hyrup Kro, where Lysegårdsvej meets Vejlevej (road 23) in Hyrup.  
**GPS** 55.711638, 9.821549  
From the meeting point it is about 2 km to parking.

**Note:** You are not allowed to enter the parking via Rosenvoldvej/Stouby Skovvej.

**Event venue  
Arena map**

The arena site and event office opens at 9:00 a.m.



**Shower**

Shower and changing facilities are not provided.  
But it's Fjord Day and Vejle fjord is just around the corner.

**Toilets**

There are toilets close to the arena on the way to the start.

**First aid**

There is a first aid tent incl. defibrillator at the arena.  
On the map is printed an emergency phone number (+45 30231150) which can be used directly for first aid.

**Kiosk**

At the arena there is a kiosk with sandwiches, pasta salad, barbecue sausages, pizza snails, cake etc. as well as drinks. We encourage you to bring your own mug for coffee / tea.  
Payment is accepted via Mobile pay, cash and card.

**Distances**

Meeting point - Parking approx. 2 km  
Parking to the arena: approx. 900 m – follow black/yellow tape.  
From arena to start: approx. 300 m – follow blue/white tape.

**Parking**

On grassland, follow the parking crew's instructions.  
DKK 20 per car must be paid for parking, these go to the owner of the field.  
Payment can be made in cash or via MobilePay to 0365WM

**Embargoed areas** Please find the embargoed area [here](#). The area is strictly embargoed. Competitors, team officials, and other persons, who, through knowledge of the terrain may influence the results of the competition, are not allowed to enter the embargoed area, unless explicitly permitted to do so by the organisers. The areas are embargoed until the respective competition is finished. It is allowed to pass through the area on paved roads.

## Timing and punching

SportIdent. Not touch-free.  
Rental cards are handed out at the start and must be returned after finish.  
Lost rental cards will be invoiced: DKK 500.

## Map

Rosenvoldskovene, drawn by Gediminas Trimakas and members of OK Snab in 2023.  
Contour interval: 5 meters.  
Scale: 1:15.000

Large distinctive tree roots higher than 2 m are marked on the map with green cross. Large and distinctive fallen trees that appear to impede the running speed are marked with a green line. However, large canopies and groups of fallen trees are drawn with the screen symbol *Vegetation fight* or with *Vegetation walk, good visibility*.

The map is printed at Grafisk Forum on water resistant paper.

Copies of the map will be present in start box 2 and 3. Possible changes on the map after printing will be shown.

Previous maps of the race area can be found on the event website. It is not allowed to bring these maps to the arena on the day (neither digitally nor in print).

## Prohibited areas

Prohibited areas are marked on the map with purple crosshatching – and in some cases also in the terrain with fully drawn red and white tape.

Areas marked with olive-green color (symbol no. 520) are always prohibited. This applies everywhere, also in cases where they are not marked with purple crosshatching on the map.

However, it is allowed to pass on path and road through the olive-green areas.


**Road passages** Athletes will pass or run along a slightly busy paved road (Rosenvoldvej). All runners must follow the guards' instructions, if any. There is a speed limit of 40 km/h on the road.

If running along the road, traffic laws must be observed. This means that **it is mandatory to run on the left side of the road.**

**Arena passage** There will be an arena passage on the course. The last control must be punched at this passage, after which a mandatory route of about 180 m must be followed. The first part of the route follows the run-in to the finish. Then keep to the right and follow white taping back into the forest.

**Map flip** There is a map flip at the arena passage.

**Marked routes** At two places, there will be white, discontinuous taping in the forest. This taping is intended for beginner/easy classes and can be neglected by WRE athletes. One of the two taped routes is shown on all maps, see below:



**Terrain** The terrain is generally hilly with many contour details. The forest consists of both deciduous and coniferous forests. The runnability is typically good, but in many places, it is also affected by seasonal undergrowth (e.g. grass, ferns, blackberries and in some places nettles). This is especially the case in open areas. The wet summer has made the undergrowth extra dense, and some tracks and trails can be difficult to see. Some paths and tracks will be cut in advance at critical locations. Ditches can also be indistinct or hidden by undergrowth.

Forest machine tracks are not all included on the map.

There are many ticks in the terrain.

### **Separate control descriptions**

Will be available at start.

Size of control descriptions:

Men: 20.0 x 4.5 cm (5 mm)

Women: 17.5 x 4.5 cm (5 mm)

Control descriptions are also printed on the map.

**Bip numbers** Bip numbers shall be worn. They are available at start.

**Start lists** Start lists can be found in Eventor <https://eventor.orienteering.org/Events/Show/7668> or on the event website. Start lists will be published on September 8.

<b>Start procedure:</b>	<p>The SI card must be cleared before entering the starting boxes. It is the athletes' own responsibility to clear.</p> <p>Box 1: Entry 4 minutes before start, name and card check – any rental card is handed out.  Box 2: Entry 3 minutes before start, control descriptions are available.  Box 3: Entry 2 minutes before start  Box 4: Entry 1 minute before start</p> <p>It is not allowed to take the map from the map box before start.</p> <p>Late starters must contact the start staff, who will then guide the athlete.</p>
<b>Hidden start</b>	<p>Marking with white tape shall be followed for 65 m to the starting point. Runners who do not pass the starting point will be disqualified.</p>
<b>Finish</b>	<p>A SI unit must be punched at the finish line. Then proceed to read-out. The map must be put in a plastic bag immediately after read-out.</p> <p>The maps can afterwards be picked up at the finish area when the last runner of the entire event has started. This is announced by the speaker around 12.30 p.m.</p>
<b>Complaints</b>	<p>Complaints can be handed in at the event office no later than 15 min after the final results of the class has been announced by the speaker.</p>
<b>Max. time</b>	<p>Maximum time is 3 hours for all classes.</p>
<b>Refreshments</b>	<p>There is self-service refreshment (water) at controls in the forest, and at the arena passage water is served. The latter is not indicated on the control description. See number of refreshment controls under Courses above.</p>
<b>Prizes</b>	<p>No. 1 in Women and Men receives DIF's championship medal.  No. 2 and 3 in Women and Men receive DOF's championship medals.</p> <p>In addition, gift cards will be awarded to the winners of the day.</p> <p>Medals are only awarded to persons who on the day of the event are members of a Danish club and is a Danish citizen or registered as a citizen in Denmark.</p> <p>The award ceremony at the arena is expected at approximately 15.00. Time is announced by the speaker.</p>
<b>Results</b>	<p>Results are displayed on screens at the arena, published in Eventor, and at the event website. They will also be continuously uploaded to <a href="https://liveresultat.orientering.se/">https://liveresultat.orientering.se/</a></p>
